Lineage. Established as 932 Troop Carrier Group, Medium, and activated, on 15 Jan 1963. Organized in the Reserve on 11 Feb 1963. Redesignated as: 932 Military Airlift Group on 1 Apr 1967; 932 Aeromedical Airlift Group (Associate) on 25 Jul 1969; 932 Airlift Wing on 1 Oct 1994.

Continental Air Command, 15 Jan 1963; 434 Troop Carrier Wing, 11 Feb 1963; 442 Military Airlift Wing, 1 Oct 1966; 514 Military Airlift Wing, 1 Apr 1969; Central Air Force Reserve Region, 1 Jan 1972; Fourteenth Air Force, 8 Oct 1976; 446 Airlift Wing, 1 Aug 1992; Fourth Air Force, 1 Oct 1994; Twenty-Second Air Force, 10 Dec 2015-.
