Lineage. Established as 92 Airdrome Group on 17 Nov 1947. Discontinued on 12 Jul 1948.

Consolidated (1 Oct 1984) with 92 Air Base Group, which was established on 28 May 1948.

Activated on 12 Jul 1948. Inactivated on 8 Aug 1952. Activated on 1 Sep 1956. Redesignated as: 92 Combat Support Group on 1 Feb 1959; 92 Support Group on 1 Sep 1991; 92 Mission Support Group on 1 Oct 2002.

Assignments. 92 Bombardment, 17 Nov 1947-8 Aug 1952. 92 Bomb (later, 92 Strategic Aerospace; 92 Bomb; 92 Wing; 92 Bomb; 92 Air Refueling) Wing, 1 Sep 1956-.
