Reestablished, redesignated as 916 Support Group, and activated in the Reserve, on 1 Aug 1992. Redesignated as 916 Mission Support Group on 1 Oct 2002.

Assignments. 916 Reserve Training Wing, 6 Aug 1951-15 Jun 1952. 916 Air Refueling Group (later, 916 Air Refueling Wing), 1 Aug 1992-.

Stations. New Castle County Aprt, DE, 6 Aug 1951-15 Jun 1952. Seymour Johnson AFB, NC, 1 Aug 1992-.
