Lineage. Constituted as 2 Space Launch Squadron on 11 Sep 1990. Activated on 1 Oct 1990. Inactivated on 31 Oct 2005. Activated on 15 Aug 2019. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 7 May 2021.

Assignments. Western Space and Missile Center, 1 Oct 1990; 30 Operations Group, 19 Nov 1991;

30 Launch Group, 1 Dec 2003-31 Oct 2005. 30 Operations Group, 15 Aug 2019; 30 Space Wing

(later, Space Launch Delta 30), 7 May 2021-.

Stations. Vandenberg AFB, CA, 1 Oct 1990-31 Oct 2005. Vandenberg AFB (later, SFB), CA, 15 Aug 2019-.
