## 22 Space Operations Squadron (SpOC)

Lineage. Constituted as 22 Space Operations Squadron on 10 Jul 1991. Activated on 1 Oct 1991.

Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 21 Oct 2020.

**Assignments.** 2 Satellite Tracking Group (later, 750 Space) Group, 1 Oct 1991; 50 Operations Group, 2 Jun 1999; 50 Network Operations Group (later, Space Delta 6), 10 Mar 2004-.

Stations. Falcon AFB (later, Shriever AFB, SFB), CO, 1 Oct 1991-.

**Service Streamers.** Global War on Terrorism – Service (GWOT-S)

Campaign Streamers. None.
