Lineage. Constituted as 30 Airdrome Squadron on 25 Jan 1943. Activated on 1 Feb 1943. Redesignated as 30 Airdrome Squadron (Special) on 16 Apr 1943. Disbanded 1 Apr 1944. Reconstituted, and redesignated as 30 Operations Support Squadron on 1 Nov 1991. Activated on 19 Nov 1991. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United

States Space Force armed force on 7 May 2021.
