328 Weapons Squadron (STARCOM)

Lineage. Constituted as 328 Bombardment Squadron (Heavy) on 28 Jan 1942. Activated on 1 Mar 1942. Redesignated as: 328 Bombardment Squadron, Heavy on 20 Aug 1943; 328 Bombardment Squadron, Very Heavy on 23 May 1945; 328 Bombardment Squadron, Medium on 28 May 1948; 328 Bombardment Squadron, Heavy on 1 Feb 1955; 328 Bomb Squadron on 1 Sep 1991. Inactivated on 15 Jun 1994. Redesignated as 328 Weapons Squadron on 24 Jan 2003. Activated on 3 Feb 2003. Changed status from a unit of United States Air Force armed force to a unit of United States Space Force armed force on 21 Oct 2020.
