Lineage. Constituted as 942 Aerial Port Flight, and activated, on 28 Jan 1964. Organized in the Reserve on 15 Feb 1964. Inactivated on 1 Jan 1972. Redesignated as 42 Mobile Aerial Port Squadron on 28 Dec 1981. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Oct 1982. Redesignated as 42 Aerial Port Squadron on 1 Oct 1987.
Assignments. 942 Troop Carrier (later, Air Transport, Military Airlift) Group, 15 Feb 1964-1 Jan 1972.
439 Tactical Airlift (later, Military Airlift, Airlift) Wing, 1 Oct 1982; 439 Operations Group, 1 Aug 1992; 439 Mission Support Group, 1 Oct 2002-.
Stations. March AFB, CA, 15 Feb 1964-1 Jan 1972. Westover AFB (later, ARB), MA, 1 Oct 1982-.
