27 Aerial Port Squadron (AFRC)

Lineage. Constituted as 2 Air Cargo Control Squadron (Special) on 15 May 1944. Activated on 20 May 1944. Inactivated on 25 Mar 1946. Disbanded on 8 Oct 1948. Reconstituted, and redesignated as 27 Mobile Aerial Port Squadron, on 17 Mar 1983. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Oct 1983. Redesignated as 27 Aerial Port Squadron on 15 Dec 1993.
