Lineage. Constituted as 916 Civil Engineering Flight on 19 Jun 1969. Activated in the Reserve on 25 Oct 1969. Inactivated on 8 Jul 1972. Consolidated (3 Oct 1984) with the 916 Civil Engineering Squadron, which was constituted on 8 Nov 1978. Activated in the Reserve on 15 Nov 1978. Inactivated on 1 Sep 1984. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Oct 1986. Redesignated as 916 Civil Engineer Squadron on 1 Mar 1994; 916 Civil Engineer Flight on 1 Nov 2008.
