Lineage. Constituted as 916 Maintenance Squadron on 3 Jul 1951. Activated in the Reserve on 6 Aug 1951. Inactivated on 15 Jun 1952. Consolidated (22 Oct 1984) with the 916 Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, which was constituted, activated, and organized in the Reserve, on 1 Dec 1965. Inactivated on 8 Jul 1972. Activated in the Reserve on 1 Oct 1987. Redesignated as 916 Maintenance Squadron on 1 Feb 1992.

Assignments. 916 Maintenance and Supply Group, 6 Aug 1951-15 Jun 1952. 916 Air Transport (later, 916 Military Airlift) Group, 1 Dec 1965-8 Jul 1972. 916 Air Refueling Group, 1 Oct 1987; 916 Logistics (later, 916 Maintenance) Group, 1 Aug 1992-.
