916 Security Forces Squadron (AFRC)

Lineage. Constituted as 916 Guard Squadron on 1 Aug 1942. Activated on 15 Aug 1942. Disbanded on 30 Apr 1944. Reconstituted, redesignated as 916 Security Police Flight, and activated in the Reserve, on 1 Oct 1988. Redesignated as: 916 Security Police Squadron on 1 Oct 1992; 916 Security Forces Squadron on 1 Jul 1997.

Assignments. West Coast AAF Training Center (later, AAF West Coast Training Center; AAF Western Flying Training Command), 15 Aug 1942-30 Apr 1944. 916 Air Refueling Group, 1 Oct 1988; 916 Support (later, 916 Mission Support) Group, 1 Aug 1992-.

Stations. Hobbs, NM, 15 Aug 1942-30 Apr 1944. Seymour Johnson AFB, NC, 1 Oct 1988-. Service Streamers. World War II: American Theater.

Campaign Streamers. None.
